Each question below is worth 10 points. We will randomly pick five (5) questions at the beginning of class. Answer each question as completely as you can giving as much detail as possible. You may not use any resources during class.

1. What is the I.P.D.E. Process?
2. How might you reduce premium rates for vehicle insurance?
3. At a social gathering, your driver has been drinking. What options do you have as you leave the gathering?
4. What are signs of impairment from the effects of alcohol?
5. List at least five expressway driving situations or conditions in which you should establish a following distance of at least three or four seconds.
6. Collisions and fatality rates are far lower on expressways than on other roadways. What are five reasons expressways have fewer collisions?
7. List four no-passing situations.
8. List four reasons for needing to crossing the center line.
9. Why do adverse weather conditions have a greater effect on a motorcyclist than on a vehicle driver?
10. Explain how to make a right turn on a red light without compromising safety.
11. What six factors should you consider before deciding which type of turnabout to use?
12. Explain the difference between a passive restraint and an active restraint. Give an example of each.
13. Explain how under-inflated, over-inflated, and properly inflated tires affect traction.
14. Explain the relationship between "getting the big picture" and "selective seeing."
15. Consider the variety of vehicles in the H.T.S. and the wide ranges of physical and emotional conditions of roadway users. What can you do to keep from being involved in collisions?
