SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Montage, Lake Park's creative arts magazine, is accepting student submissions up until
January 13, 2012.

Categories:

- Short Story
- Poetry
- Organic Art (sketches/drawings/paintings, etc.)
- Digital Art
- Photography
- Sculpture

Note: ("Fan art" and copyrighted images will NOT be accepted).

Submission:

- All submissions must include the creator's name; however, we do honor anonymous work when publishing.
- Do not write your name directly on your work; we code entries so judges will not know the name of the artist.
- Write your ID number on the back of your submission.
- Attach a submission form to your art work when you drop it off in the RC.
- You must type your short story and poem entries and enter them online only.
- Limit short stories to no more than 3 pages of double-spaced submissions in Times New Roman, 12-point font.
- A maximum of 3 works will be published per person, per category; only 6 submissions total may be submitted for judging, per person, per category.
- Note that reproduction of images may be in black and white (color submissions will be accepted). Color pages are limited.
- Original copies of art will be returned to the artist.
- The editorial board reserves the right to review submissions for copyright infringements.
- Your work may be altered due to content or length, yet *Montage* will make all efforts to contact the artist prior to publication.

When is the last day submissions will be accepted?
